


Level of Concentration in the Classroom3




The teachers encourage the students to listen to the lectures in the class and prepare notes by themselves which help them to improve their writing and analytical skills for future.




Requirement of Vocational Courses in the future




Availability and Use of Smart Classrooms/ LCD Projector

Recommendations:

- 1. Few teachers were found chewing tobacco products in the classroom. Teachers can be reminded to follow classroom etiquette.
- 2. Teachers should moderate their pace of teaching and balance between covering the course on time as well as make students understand the subject-matter.
- 3. Students Union Election should be more democratic and representative but should not be based on petty factionalism on Tribal lines. 70% of the respondents feel that tribalism was the most detrimental factor in Students' Union Election.

- 4. Some classrooms are overcrowded. 60% of the respondents expressed the difficulty of concentration in the classroom.
- 5. 50% of respondents complained about noisy corridor during class hours as students stand in the corridor and wait for the next class.
- 6. 70% of the respondents complained the lack of safe drinking facility in the college despite the installation of Water ATM machine. Water ATM Cards should be issued to the Class Representatives to fill this gap.
- 7. 85% of the respondents complained about scarcity of water and unhygienic conditions of the student toilets. Students should be given the responsibility to keep the toilets clean. If possible, every section per semester can take care of their toilets on each floor on rotational basis.
- 8. 70% of the respondents shared the need of additional College Bus.
- 9. 35% of the respondents suggested for better quality Canteen in the college.
- 10. In order to encourage good students and create healthy competition amongst the students, acknowledgement for the highest scorers in all the semester exams is suggested.
- 11. Information for class dismissal and other information should be given on time.
- 12. More revisional classes should be conducted for better results.
- 13. Some respondents expressed the need for more optional subjects. The college may think about introduction of more disciplines.
- 14. Although the College is Wifi-enabled, 75% the respondents complained about the low accessibility of Wifi.
