The Library is on the process of using ILMS, SOUL 2.0 after a brief hiatus due to lack of manpower and technical expertise. SOUL is being used for automation of Library housekeeping operations and cataloguing of its holdings. Library users can access the Library's catalogue of resources through the Online Public Access Catalogue OPAC which is the digital database of the resources held by the Library. To obtain specific data/reports of the collection, there are various parameters to generate it such as Accession number, Department, Shelving location etc. The integrated feature of bar-code enables generation of bar-code. Each book is bar-coded with a unique number for bibliographic identification and to facilitate efficient circulation of check-in and check-out. Membership card too is being bar-coded for valid identification and for accessing the Library's resources by the card holder.

The ILMS, SOUL is installed with the assistance of a local IT firm. The data entry works are being done by the Library staff in addition to outsourcing it in order to alleviate work load of the Library. The set-up and operation of the various modules of the software is being managed by the Librarian.

Currently, there is no Library portal in the College website to access the Library's catalogue and also to keep track of users' e-access. The Library has no systems of RFID and ERP technology, it is still solely based on physical workflow.

There are eleven computer systems in the Library for the students. Each system is equipped with internet, MS office, and access to on-campus e-books. There are two photocopiers in the Library where students can make photocopy of library materials at nominal rate.

The Library runs on internet band-width of 300 LAN and 80 Wi-Fi Mbps for its in-house automated operations as well as internet provision to the Library users.
