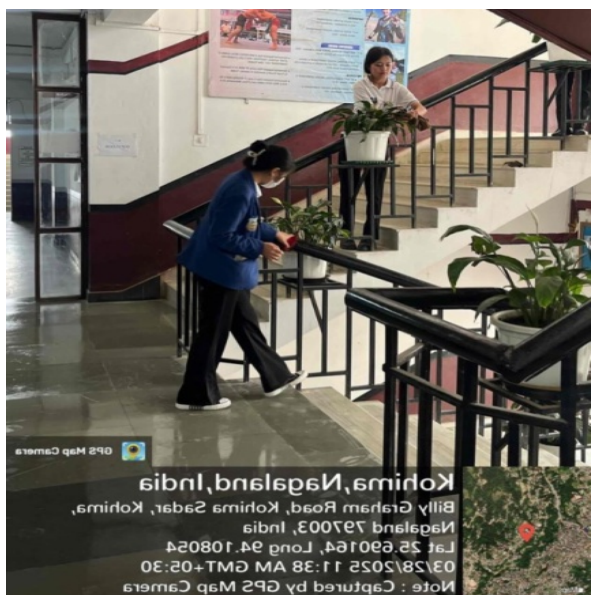
## Awareness program on Substance Use Disorder – 6th March 2025
