





## 2.2 - Catering to Student Diversity

2.2.1 - The institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organizes special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners

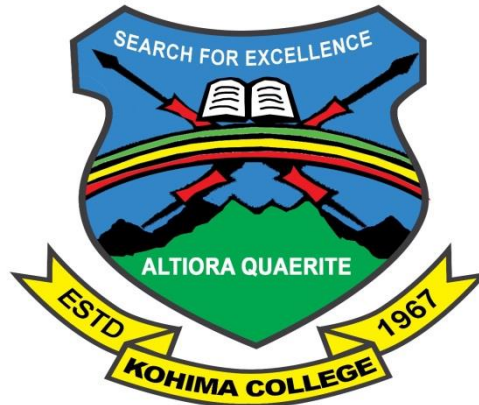
Kohima College recognises the divergence among learners as a natural phenomenon. College organizes special programmes for advanced learners and slow learners. At the beginning of an academic year, the College conducts an orientation program for the first years to give an overview of Teaching-Learning practices, Student Support and Extension Activities, and Examination system. No particular programme is charted out for identification of advanced and slow learners however it is mostly assessed through the students' performance not only in academics but also in their performance in extracurricular activities. Advanced learners are encouraged to excel through special mentorship and exposure opportunities. Such students are also deputed to represent the college in various forums to participate in academic events, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. This will further enhance their learning and social skills that will prepare them for higher studies.

Remedial classes are conducted for slow learners. Students lagging behind in internal tests are given the opportunity for retest. One to one meeting between teacher and student with low class attendance and poor performances in class test is also done. Assistance is provided through Revision classes, discussion of Previous Question papers, study material, and question banks.

To encourage and acknowledge the academic achievement of students at the university level, the college has constituted a number of awards like Dr. Satuo Sekhose Award Star Pupil Award, 'Scholar's badge', Alumni Association Award, 'Meritorious Award' for subject toppers in Economics, History, Political Science and Tenyidie.

**2.3 - Teaching- Learning Process**

2.3.1 - Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences

The College actively works towards cultivating an intellectually stimulating learning environment wherein students are trained to develop their innate talent and realize their potential to the maximum. A series of events, talks, workshops, field trips, seminars, and webinars are organized to provide beyond the classroom exposure and hands-on experience to students for their holistic growth and overall well-being.

To develop social, ethical and personal values, students are encouraged to enrol in NSS, NCC, Red Ribbon Club, Swachh Bharat cells. These cells extend support in the college activities and in community services through awareness program on various issues. Besides these, college activities like Sports week, Literary and Cultural Day, Freshers' Day, Parting Social and Prize Distribution Day are organised by the students themselves. This helps develop students' leadership skills, decision making, organizational skills and to shoulder responsibilities. Students are encouraged to take part in debates, quiz and poster competitions, etc. organized by other institutions as well as by the college.

Department specific activities like study tours, field visits, talk series, museum visits are organized which exposes students to real life situations and gives them a firsthand experience about the topics that are taught in classrooms.

2.3.2 - Teachers use ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process. Write description in maximum of 200 words

ICT-enabled tools continue to play a vital role in the teaching learning process of the institution.

The college has 17 classrooms equipped with projectors and 2 smart boards which are used for different activities as well as for teaching purposes. Teachers use ICT tools like desktop, laptops and smartphones for easier communication with the students. WhatsApp Groups are formed for disseminating important information, providing additional resources and reading materials in the form of PDF notes, PPT, e books, to students. Google Classroom and Google Meet are used as and when required for seminars and classes. Various online competitions like Quizzes, project presentations, e-Poster making competitions, Video presentations etc. were conducted to keep the students motivated. Google forms are used for registration of events and feedback collections





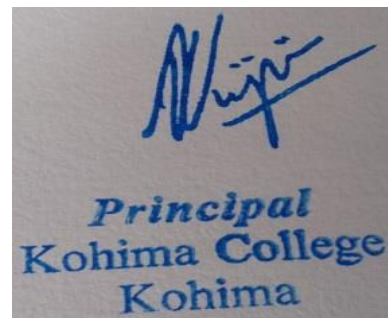

## 2.5 - Evaluation Process and Reforms

2.5.1 - Mechanism of internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and mode. Write description within 200 words.

The College's examination system is transparent and robust. All the students are clearly informed about the Exam dates, Question paper pattern, evaluation procedure, weightage of internal and external marks allotment as per the regulation provided by the parent university.

The timetable for internal examinations is prepared by the Exam Committee and approved by the Principal and displayed well in advance. The teachers prepare question papers and submit them to the exam branch well before the internal exams. A centralized seating arrangement and invigilation duties are prepared by the Examination Committee and are displayed in the notice boards as well as in WhatsApp groups.

Students failing to sit for internal tests or write assignments, due to genuine reasons are given a chance to complete the same within a stipulated time. To ensure transparency students are informed of their performance and marks secured.

Regular departmental meetings are held to ensure that teachers take regular class tests, assignments etc. for an effective evaluation of the students. Marks obtained by students are submitted to the HoDs, which is further reviewed and tabulated by the Examination Committee.

2.5.2 - Mechanism to deal with internal examination related grievances is transparent, time-bound and efficient

The college uses the following mechanism to deal with internal examination related grievances to ensure a transparent process and in the best interest of the students.

- ♦ The college has an Examination committee, with the Principal as the chairman and all the HoDs as members. This committee is responsible to oversee all exam related matters.
- ♦ For the redressal of any exam related issues, students can write an application seeking redressal through the Grievance Redressal Cell of the college or meet any of the committee members personally with a written complaint for reevaluation of the particular paper. The application will then be forwarded to the HoD of the concerned department to be appropriately addressed by the concerned teacher.
- ♦ Appeals should be made as soon as possible after the marks are given out. The teacher is expected to respond within two days. Students resorting to unfair means in the examination hall are strictly dealt with as per the rules laid down by the college.
- ♦ Marks awarded by the individual teachers are further scrutinized by the respective HoDs, before submitting it to the Examination Committee.

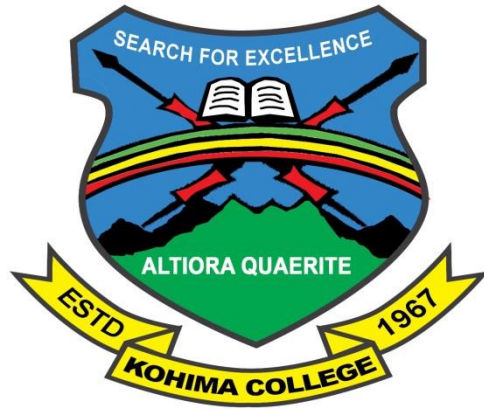

2.6.2 - Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution.

Kohima College measures the attainment of the Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course Outcomes (COs) through the evaluation systems for each programme in various ways. The primary way of evaluating learning outcomes is through continuous assessment, including the internal assessment prescribed by the affiliating University. Continuous assessment of the students is done using a variety of examination methods, including projects, presentations, group discussions, research surveys, class activities, quizzes etc.

#### Evaluation Process:

The programme outcomes and programme specific outcomes are assessed with the help of course outcomes of the relevant programme through direct evaluation process. It is provided

through University Examinations, internal and home assignments, unit tests, surprise tests, etc. Average attainment in Evaluation Process:

Students under university examination are evaluated for 75% of total marks and institution for 25% marks as internal assessment. Students enrolled for Add On/Certificate Courses offered by the institution are evaluated by the institution itself. At the same time, observations of student knowledge and skills against measurable course outcomes are evaluated throughout the year.

Job Placement and Students progression to higher education is also another indication for the attainment of programme outcome.




