Entrance Test 2026

1. Ancient Indian History (From Earliest Times to 1206)
2. Medieval Indian History (C. 1206.-1757)
3. Modern Indian History 1757- 1947
4. History of Europe 1789-1945

Note:

- **Full marks: 50**
(40 mark for entrance test, 10 marks weight-age will be given to Academic performance in Under Graduate examinations).
- Descriptive type test: 10 marks X 4 questions= 40 Marks.
- Total Time for Entrance Examination: 1 hour, 30 minutes.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to the M.A. History Programme

1. Candidates who have completed a Bachelor's Degree with History as an Honours/Major subject shall be given preference over candidates from the General/Pass stream who have studied History as a Minor/Elective subject.
2. Applicants must have successfully completed a three-year Bachelor's Degree:
 - Candidates with History Honours/Major must have secured a minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
 - Candidates from the General/Pass Arts stream seeking admission to the programme must have secured a minimum of 55% marks in History, the subject in which admission is sought.
3. A relaxation of 5% in the minimum qualifying marks may be granted to candidates belonging to the Exceptional Sports Category, subject to the relevant rules and regulations.
4. Preference shall be given to candidates who have graduated from Government, Private, or Autonomous Colleges affiliated with Nagaland University, over applicants from other universities.
5. The total intake capacity for the programme shall be 30 seats.
6. Reservation of seats shall be governed by the prevailing norms and regulations of the Government of India and Nagaland University.
